

Fruit processing company Tricom plans to expand domestic footprint with purees

Maharashtra-based Tricom Fruit Products India Limited, a company engaged in multi-fruit processing, has announced its expansion plans after completing one year of operations. The company, within first year of commencing its fruit processing operations, has won an image in the international markets, according to a press note released by the company recently.

After having established itself in the export market in the first year of operations, the company is now planning to gain its foothold in the domestic market. New product development in terms of processing of new fruits and vegetable purees would also be a key priority. The company intends to double its processing capacity from current 10 tonnes per hour to 20 tonnes per hour for mango and pomegranate and from five tonnes per hour to 10 tonnes per hour for guava, papaya, tomato and gooseberry (amla).
